I would sincerely like to thank all of our age managers, starters, time keepers, place judges, race recorders and there are many of you that jump in and help out with the children on a Friday night. Without our wonderful helpers, we are unable to run our program. Thank You!

There were quite a few new families to the centre this season and so many parents were always there to help out. Thank you all again!

A big thank you to my fellow committee members, our club functions because of our fantastic committee. Everyone has a job and you all do it with a smile on your face.....most of the time anyway! Thank you all for your support and your contribution to the running of our Little Athletics Centre.

A special thank you to Ann and Bob Hay, our wonderful BBQ duo, your job is not easy sometimes, but we appreciate all the effort you have put into our BBQ this season!

As you will see when your child/children receive their trophy tonight, they will receive their results from the season, all of our Little Athletes have improved with their running, jumping and throwing. All results are entered into the computer. Each child receives 1 point for entering an event and a bonus point for bettering a previous result (Personal Best). That is how the Gold Point Score is decided. The athlete with the highest point score for the season wins the Gold Point Score award. Second and third are also awarded, all athletes that have attended 4 nights of competition receive a trophy for participation.

Our Centre Championships were conducted over 2 weeks in December. Athletes were awarded 15 points for a first place, 10 points for second place, 7 points for third place and 5 points were awarded for all minor placings. Medals were presented in February to the athletes placing $1^{\rm st}$, $2^{\rm nd}$ and $3^{\rm rd}$ for each boy and girl in the U7 to U17 age group and all Tots and U6's received a medal for participation. I'm sure that there are still some medals that need to be picked up.

I do hope that all of the Tiger Wests Little Athletes had a wonderful season. Remember guys, it is not all about coming first, it is about BEING YOUR BEST!

State Championships were held over 3 days Friday 20^{th} March, Saturday 21^{st} March and Sunday 22nd March at Sydney Olympic Park Athletics Centre, Homebush.
