1. Total income for this season totalled \$24,600 which was up nearly 50% thanks to the generous Dooley's Grant of \$5500. This meant our club was in the black this season.
2. BBQ sales contributed greatly raising averaging \$250 per night thanks to the great weather. In addition, our first Bunnings BBQ raised \$1700 so well done to all volunteers.
3. Our club is now required to contribute to rent for the grounds with \$2,889 covering the last 2 seasons rent.

I would like to acknowledge once again Allan Thatcher and Cherine who not only led the "BBQ Team" this season but did an outstanding job co-ordinating our first Bunnings BBQ fundraising. Thank you to Alan and the rest of the BBQ Team for ensuring we never ran out of BBQ supplies and to all members for supporting the BBQ. Thank you to all committee members overseeing the registration, uniform and all volunteers who contributed great and small to this wonderful result. Championships Officer's Report

Hi Everyone,

It was my pleasure this year to take on the job as the Championships officer. The club had a fantastic year in our competition season.

It all started with the **Inner West Zone Track & Field Championships** on the weekend of the 9th & 10th December at ES Marks field Kensington.

We had 29 athletes put their hand up and come out to compete this weekend, competing in 94 events. Of these 94 events 9 of our athletes managed to get 28 finishes in the top 6.

In the U7 boys **Tamati Filipaina** had a great day with the Discus throwing 11.77m to pick up the 3rd place bronze medal, while **Elijah Joe** also did extremely well with a 5th place finish in the Long Jump 2.65m. Both these boys didn't get to progress as the U7's stop at Zone but I'm sure this experience will drive them on for next season.

Other notable performances at the zone carnival were **Hassanatu Kamara** missing top 8 to make it to the 100m final by 0.03 sec finishing 9th & her sister **Mariam Kamara** finishing 11th and only missing the 100m final by 0.35 sec. Top effort girls I'm sure with some training next year you will make Regionals.

Darius Lerotic & Christopher MacDonald were also impressive in the U9 Boys High Jump being 0.14 & 0.19 off the winning mark to finish 8th & 9th.

Anthony del Popolo had his worst ever comp with his Discus fouling twice then hitting the net to just bounce in 5.77m he normally throws over 20m, but I was so proud of the way he came back the next day & only missed top 6 in Shot Put by 0.26m coming in at 9th.

Grace Harper: Long Jump & **Ben Long:** 800m also had a 10th place finish which I hope encourages them to strive to work harder for next year.

Victoria Oreshkin in qualifying for the Regionals also set a new **Club Record** at Zone of 30.05m in the javelin.

Our next outing was the **Region 8 Track & Field Championships** on the 3rd & 4th of February at The Ridge Athletics Track, Barden Ridge.

This saw these 9 athletes as well as Alex del Popolo who got exemption because he was overseas when zone was on compete in 20 events.

3 of our athletes got top 2 finishes to give them automatic qualification

Renato Pane:-Discus, 100m & Long Jump with a Regional Record 6.05m

Victoria Oreshkin :-Javelin & **Matthew Macdonald** :-60m Hurdles both finished well enough to make the **Tiger West State team** after a nervous wait to see how the other Regions performed.

Incredibly **Renato** also ended up making the State Championships in his other 3 events.

Alex del Popolo in qualifying for the State also set a new **Club Record** at 37.50m in the Javelin. Also **Kieren Shaw** in qualifying for the State set a new **Club Record** at 12.93 in the Shot Put.

Maisy 1500m 4th & **Tamikah** Shot Put 4th both competed extremely well & can count themselves unlucky not to have made the cut.

So that moved us onto the **State Track & Field Championships** on the 23rd – 25th March at **SOPAC**.

All our athletes compete admirably but special mention should probably go to **Alex** for coming **5th in the State in his Javelin**.

But our most impressive athlete of the competition season is undoubtedly **Renato** who as previously mentioned made state in all 6 events that he tried out in.

His program took its toll on him and you could see that he was tired by the end of it, but to his credit **Renato** finish **5th in the State in Discus**.

Incredibly his last event was his best with his Regional record in his sites he jumped 8cm further to take out the 1st place & therefore **U14's NSW Little Athletics Champion for the Long Jump**. This was a new **Club Record** 6.13m; **Renato** also set 2 other **Club Records** at Regional; Discus 48.19m & Triple Jump 11.66m.

All up that was 4 athletes setting **6 new Club Records** over the completion season, awesome effort. Well done to all of the athletes that competed throughout the whole of our completion season. For one of the smallest clubs in the State we definitely punch well above our weight. It has been a pleasure to organise these events & I look forward to another great year.
