# Presidents Report

What a season. As we look back over the season we are struck by the variety of challenges that not only Tiger Wests faced but the whole of the NSW Little Athletics community had to deal with.

There were heat waves that meant we were not able to compete due to the record high temperatures, an unprecedented bushfire season stopped much of the competition through November and December due to hazardous air quality over much of Sydney, a number of storms also hampered competition and now the COVID-19 pandemic has meant that the completion of the season and its required formalities have been impacted also.

The number of athletes that we have had attend each of the Friday night competition nights has been variable due to the conditions being so erratic. Even at Zone, Regional and State competition these impacts have been felt. The Zone carnival had to be carried out with a modified program due to hazardous air quality and many athletes were not able to compete due to health considerations. The Regional Carnival itself highlighted the variability of the seasons weather conditions with the carnival being delayed on Saturday due to extreme heat and then on Sunday events having to be run during a torrential downpour.

This season has been very challenging personally for myself and my daughters. On the 23<sup>rd</sup> January 2020 Elizabeth Oreshkin passed away after a 6 month hospital admission. During this time the committee stepped up and ran the club seamlessly. I sincerely and deeply thank the club and the committee for its support for our family during this difficult season. I would personally and deeply like to thank the hard working Club Committee who worked tirelessly all season to ensure that the competition was held each Friday night that wasn't cancelled due to weather conditions. Without the work that these guys put in we would not have had registrations sorted, uniforms ordered and available for athletes to wear. We would not have the weekly schedule of events and the recording of results, as well as the BBQ for each Friday night and the equipment that we all use. Also a special thank you to Peter and Karen Harper for taking charge during the Zone and Regional Carnivals when I was not able.

In comparison to the other clubs in our zone you will find that Tiger Wests is one of the smaller Clubs. The smaller size allows us to spend more time each Friday night in teaching the skills that the athletes need to progress in athletics. Being a smaller club we also rely heavily on our parents to help out on Friday nights during competition. This allows our parents to learn skills in managing age groups, officiating and training athletes. I am pleased to say that this year our parents continued helping out each week being very willing to assist. I trust that they also enjoyed helping out.

With the season now closed the Committee positions are available for new nominations. I strongly encourage all parents to consider nominating for a committee position. Over the years that I have had the privilege of being your president I have found that a vibrant and active committee is essential to the success of a season of athletics competition. So again I encourage all to participate in running the club as a committee member, it is a rewarding endeavour and does assist in your child's progress through the athletics pathways.

The BBQ team has again been headed up by Alan and Cherine Randell this year provided a great meal each and every week. Even when the weather conditions meant we could not compete, we at least had a good meal before going home. The BBQ is also a very important fund raising endeavour for the Club. This year Peter Ford organised a sponsorship through Steggles so we were able to enjoy the addition of chicken kebabs to the BBQ menu.

With the season now complete we focus on the 2020-2021 season and I encourage all parents and athletes to promote the Club to their circle of friends and acquaintances so that the new season sees an increase in numbers.

## Treasurer's Report

During the season we had a surplus of about \$2,857.

We didn't make any large equipment purchases. (Last year we spent \$7,700 on a container to house equipment.) And we didn't make large purchases of uniforms, again unlike last year.

Income items were fairly similar to last year. Active Kids vouchers gave us an extra \$1,000 and we sold more uniforms.

Expenditure was on the usual items.

As in the previous year, registration fees were collected by LANSW and sent on to us after they deducted their fee. They also processed the Active Kids vouchers and sent the funds to us.

Barbecues on competition nights continue to be a major source of income for the Club, raising a net \$2,300 during the year. A barbecue at Bunnings raised \$730, and a barbecue at a school carnival raised \$425. Thank you very much to those who do such a fine job feeding us and raising these funds.

We continue to share the costs of ground rent with the Senior Club. They pay 80% and we pay 20%.

I am grateful to Edward Duffy for auditing the accounts.
